<b>Cidery (&amp;County),</b>	<b>Name,</b>	<b>Alcohol by Volume</b>
<b>Kent Cider Co (Kent),</b>	<b>Spiced,</b>	<b>5.0%</b>
With this year's cider making drawing to a close Kent Cider are making a delicious Spiced Cider. Fresh ginger, cinnamon, cloves, star anise all go into the making of this scrumptious sweet cider.		
<b>Big Tree (Kent),</b>	<b>Appley Ever After,</b>	<b>5.8%</b>
Now in its second year, and gives a pleasant sparkle on the tongue followed by a dry, fruity taste..		
<b>Big Tree (Kent),</b>	<b>Fruity Beauty,</b>	<b>5.8%</b>
In partnership with Besmoke of Arundel, a natural smoke specialist a fantastic seasonal ale to coincide with Bonfire season which is fast approaching. ABV dark red ale with subtle hints of smoked woody malts followed on by the sweet floral smoky notes coming over with the smoked green hops.		
<b>Big Tree (Kent),</b>	<b>Lispig Cowboy,</b>	<b>5.8%</b>
new cider available this year. This drink is a blend of Cox and Bramley, a medium dry, refreshing cider with a subtle sharpness.		
<b>East Stour (Kent),</b>	<b>East Stour Dry,</b>	<b>6.8%</b>
A dry, still cider made from a blend of apple varieties.		
<b>East Stour (Kent),</b>	<b>East Stour Medium,</b>	<b>6.9%</b>
A medium, still cider made from a blend of apple varieties.		
<b>East Stour (Kent),</b>	<b>East Stour Blackcurrant,</b>	<b>6.8%</b>
A dry, still cider made from a blend of apple varieties with the addition of blackcurrants.		
<b>Severn Cider (Gloucestershire),</b>	<b>Brown Snout Cider,</b>	<b>6.4%</b>
Absolutely delicious, described as fruity and rounded; very easy drinking. A delight to drink on its own or with food and friends. Selected as BEST from nearly one hundred ciders at the Worcestershire Cider and Beer Festival.		
<b>Severn Cider (Gloucestershire),</b>	<b>Blakeney Red Perry,</b>	<b>6.4%</b>
After last year's success it had to return. The Blakeney Red pear originates from the village of Blakeney and is also called Painted Lady, probably from the bold red blushes on the pears.
