Sweet and fruity, hoppy backnotes imparting pleasant bitterness

A flavour-packed IPA. Challenger & First Gold hops give citrus notes

Pale hoppy citrus beer. Winner of Beer of SVR festival in 2011!

Classic best bitter. Roast and caramel malt flavours

**Dark Star** (W. Sussex), *Espresso* (4.2%) TW

Rich black beer made with ground Arabica coffee beans—really!

**Dark Star**, *Green Hopped IPA* (6.5%) TW

Strong, full-flavoured IPA, with fresh Simcoe and Target hops

**Downlands** (W. Sussex), *Pale* (4.1%) TW

Subtle toffee sweetness underlie fruity hop punch. Quaffable

**Downlands**, *Green Hop* (4.7%) TW

Freshly picked hops impart a unique character to this pale beer

**Downlands**, *Devil's Dyke Porter* (5.0%) TW

Complex dark ale with toffee, chocolate and smoky flavours

**FILO** (E. Sussex), *Old Town Tom* (4.5%) TW

Light, ginger-infused ale with hint of lemony hop

**FILO**, *Cardinal* (4.6%) TW

Smooth, black porter full of chocolate malt and roasted barley

**Goachers** (Kent), *Real Mild Ale* (3.4%) GR

Flavoursome, drinkable ale with roasted malt and chocolate taste

**Goachers**, *Gold Star* (5.1%) TW

Popular pale ale with Kent Goldings hops and Maris Otter malt

**Goody Ales** (Kent), *Green Hop Genesis* (3.5%) TW

Dark ruby full flavoured ale, this time made with fresh green hops

**Goody Ales**, *Green Hop Good Life* (3.9%) TW

Pale ale bursting with fresh golden citrusy hops

**Goody Ales**, *Green Hop Good Sheppard* (4.5%) GR

Deep amber ale with usually soft mouthfeel given a fresh hop boost

**Grainstore** (Rutland), *Triple B* (4.2%) TW

Well balanced bitter with malty sweetness and clean aftertaste

**Grainstore**, *Rutland Beast* (5.3%) TW

Dark, earthy brown in colour. Rich roasted flavour.

**Hammerpot** (W. Sussex), *Mosaic Pale Ale* (4.3%) GR

Crisp, hoppy beer with hints of lemon, peach mango and pine

**Hammerpot**, *Red Hunter* (4.3%) TW

Smooth, rich, full-bodied dark ruby bitter

**Hastings** (E. Sussex), *Session Pale* (4.0%) SET A

5 malts & dry-hopping give full flavoured hazy **unfined** **vegan** ale

**Hastings**, *Four Cees APA* (5.7%) SET B

4 US hops give a crisp body and citrus/pine resin taste. **Unfined**

**High Weald** (E. Sussex), *Greenstede Gold* (4.0%) TW

Refreshing golden beer produced with UK & US hops

**High Weald**, *Chronicle* (4.1%) TW

Sussex bitter. Floral aroma, sweet malt, toffee hints, clean finish

**Hop Fuzz** (Kent), *Northern Star* (4.4%) GR

Traditional style best bitter with hint of sweetness from honey

**Hop Fuzz**, *Black Bomb* (4.6%) TW

No details except that fresh green hops used in brewing. Dark?

**Kent** (Kent), *Brewers Reserve* (5.0%) TW

Dry-hopped pale ale. Resinous citrus flavour balanced with malt

**Kent**, *Maple Wheat IPA* (5.8%) TW

New beer, quite bitter for style. Maple aroma, some sweetness

**Kissingate** (W. Sussex), *Old Tale Porter* (4.5%) TW

Dark chocolate and hints of woodsmoke with mild bitterness

**Kissingate**, *Chennai Premium IPA* (5.0%) TW

Sweet citrus fruits and pine resin flavours with bittersweet finish

**Larkins** (Kent), *Green Hop Best* (4.0%) TW

Fresh hop best bitter. Winner of last year's Beer of the Festival!

**Larkins**, *Pale* (4.2%) TW

New this year. Single malt coloured. Fruity, but no grapefruit!

**Larkins**, *Best Bitter* (4.4%) TW

Rich, fruity ale. Summer fruits, caramel and perfect bitterness

**Larkins**, *Porter* (5.4%) TW

Legendary dark rich winter beer. Vinous, roasty and warming.

**Long Man** (E. Sussex), *Scary Man* (4.3%) TW

A malty monster of a beer. An old ale with molasses undertones

**Long Man**, *American Pale Ale* (4.8%) ER

Triple-hopped amber beer. Subtle citrus aroma, robust bitterness

**Mad Cat** (Kent), *Pow Wow Session Pale Ale* (3.6%) TW

American hops produce a fruity balanced refreshing light beer

**Mad Cat**, *Jet Black Stout* (4.6%) GR

Full bodied, hints of coffee and dark chocolate. Dark fruity hops

**Musket** (Kent), *Fife and Drum* (3.8%) TW

Golden ale with complex aromas & tastes; floral, honey, spices

**Musket**, *Muzzleloader* (5.0%) GR

Smokey and dark with faint aromas of spice and oranges

**Oakham** (Cambs.), *Jeffery Hudson Bitter* (3.8%) GR

JHB is a straw-coloured ale with citrus hop character. Dry finish

**Oakham**, *Inferno* (4.0%) ER

Golden beer with citrus fruitiness building to pleasant bitterness

**Old Dairy** (Kent), *Red Top* (3.8%) GR

Sweetish copper-coloured bitter. Hints of caramel, subtle hops

**Old Dairy**, *Cattle Shed* (4.5%) TW

Very hoppy American-style pale ale. Light in colour. Citrusy

Classic pale ale using Kent hops to give a delightful spicy finish

**Pig & Porter, *Strangely Brown* (4.8%) TW**

Intriguing green-hopped porter. Blackadder would approve!

**Pig & Porter, *Purest Green* (5.2%) TW**

An alchemy of fresh East Kent Goldings make this tasty pale ale

**Portobello (London), *Star* (4.3%) ER**

Floral, smooth, balanced amber bitter with coffee notes to finish

**Portobello, *Autumn Red* (4.4%) TW**

Delicate red ale, with subtle complexity and smokey hints at end

**Ramsgate (Kent), *Gadd's Rye Pale Ale* (4.0%) TW**

Crisp, hoppy & spicy. Malted rye plus Kent Bramling Cross hops

**Ramsgate, *Gadd's Green Hop Ale* (4.8%) TW**

Lots of fresh resinous zesty hops with balancing malt undertow

**Ripple Steam (Kent), *Original Best Bitter* (4.1%) TW**

Rich, traditional fruity ale with hints of apricots.

**Ripple Steam, *Farmhouse Pale* (4.2%) TW**

Floral amber ale with crisp malt and fresh green Fuggles hops

**Rockin' Robin (Kent), *Hop Rock It* (4.0%) TW**

Dark malts combine with delicate green hop bouquet and taste

**Rother Valley (Kent), *Hoppers Ale* (4.4%) TW**

Burnished copper caramel tasting ale made with Golding hops

**Rother Valley, *Ruby Wheat* (4.7%) TW**

Interesting beer with orange-chocolate flavours and subtle hops

Distinct ale; delicate floral Alsace hops and caramel maltiness

**Tonbridge, Rustic** (4.0%) TW

Rich, deep bronze 'country ale'. Lightly hopped, spicy notes

**Tonbridge, Capel Pale Green Hop** (4.5%) TW

Zesty pale ale with pronounced grapefruit and honey flavours

**Tonbridge, Union Pale** (4.7%) TW

American style pale ale with biscuit malt and zesty citrus finish

**Triple fff** (Hants.), **Smells Like Team Spirit** (4.8%) TW

Flavoursome beer using green hops from Hants/Surrey border

**Truman's** (London), **Swift** (3.9%) TW

Lip-smacking golden ale with refreshing hops and mellow malt

**Truman's, Runner** (4.0%) GR

Dark copper best bitter packed with a host of complex flavours

**Wantsum** (Kent), **Black Prince** (3.9%) TW

A rich and full-flavoured mild ale. Smooth with subtle hop tones

**Wantsum, Bramling Cross Green Hop Ale** (4.5%) TW

Best bitter with fresh BC hops. Blackcurrant tones, floral spices

**Wantsum, Bullion Green Hop Ale** (4.5%) TW

Best bitter with fresh Bullion hops. Floral, blackcurrant & spices

**Weird Beard** (London), **Black Pearle** (4.5%) TW

A coffee milk stout. Sweetish roast notes throughout. Dry finish

**Westerham** (Kent), **Summer Pearle** (3.8%) GR

Golden ale brewed using 9 Kent hop types. Tropical fruits abound

Full-bodied bitter with Kentish hops for aroma and a 'sappy' taste

**Westerham, *Audit Ale* (6.2%) TW**

Complex strong ale, with deep malts and Kent Goldings hops

**Whitstable (Kent), *Pearl of Kent* (4.5%) TW**

Light coloured, rounded golden ale. Tropical fruit flavours

**Whitstable (Kent), *Kentish Reserve* (5.0%) ER**

Reddish amber premium bitter. Stone fruit flavours. Port finish

**Windsor & Eton (Berks.), *Parklife* (3.2%) TW**

Refreshing light ale full of a selection of citrusy New World hops

**Windsor & Eton, *Conqueror* (5.5%) TW**

A black IPA. Roast malt fights with citrus hops. A Marmite beer!

Full on lemon and dill notes in surprisingly smooth strong beer

**Burning Sky (E. Sussex), *Saison L'Automne* (4.2%) SET A**

French-style seasonal beer. Tart crispness balanced with rosehips

**Dark Star (W. Sussex), *Revelation* (5.7%) SET A**

Five hops in the mash, then dry-hopped using the 'hoptimizer'!

**Kernel (London) *London 1890 Export Stout* (7.0%) SET A**

Intense black. Roast, rum & raisin flavour. Herbal oily hop bitterness

### Brewery (& County), *Beer Name*, % Alcohol By Volume

**Oakham** (Cambs.), *Green Devil* (6.0%) SET A

Hop harvest aroma with tropical fruit bursting through. Crisp finish

**Pig & Porter**, *Honey Hill Wit* (5.0%) SET A

New wheat beer. Hints of cloves, orange zest and late-added honey

**Weird Beard** (London), *Little Things That Kill* (3.8%) SET A

A 'violently' hoppy session pale ale! Fresh fruit and grassy notes

**Westerham**, *Hop Rocket India Pale Ale* (5.5%) SET A

Deep golden, thirst quenching. Quadruple hopped then dry-hopped

Dry but smooth, quaffable cider with hint of classic Kent sharpness

**BEARDspoon**, *Undecider'd* (6.5%) ER

Medium cider; Bramley tang, Russet depth, Discovery sweetness

**Biddenden** (Kent), *Bushels Medium Dry* (6.0%) GR

**Biddenden**, *Strong Kentish Medium* (8.0%) SET A

**Biddenden**, *Strong Kentish Dry* (8.0%) TW

Still ciders made with culinary and dessert apples

**Double Vision** (Kent), *One Vision Sweet* (5.2%) TW

Made with 5 varieties of Kentish apples; from Bramley's to Russets

**Double Vision**, *Medium Dry Perry* (6.0%) GR

Made from Kent Conference pears

**Duddas Tun** (Kent), *Disco Dudda* (5.3%) TW

Single variety medium dry cider made from Discovery apples

**Duddas Tun** (Kent), *Spiced* (5.5%) TW

Subtle aromatic spices which do not detract from apple flavour

**Duddas Tun, *Perry* (5.5%) SET A**

Award-winning medium dry perry using pears grown on their farm

**Gibbet Oak (Kent), *Falstaff/Bramley* (5.7%) TW**

Dry cider made with Falstaff and Bramley apples

**Gibbet Oak (Kent), *Perry* (5.7%) ER**

Medium dry perry. Runner up at Kent Beer & Cider Festival 2015

**Gibbet Oak, *Dry* (7.5%) TW**

Dry cider made from Russet apples grown on their own farm

**Longtail (Kent), *Perry* (5.0%) TW**

Medium dry. Made from Comice & Conference pears from Higham-

**Longtail, *Golden* (6.0%) SET B**

Medium dry cider. Made from Cox & Bramleys from Higham

**Longtail (Kent), *Black Dog* (6.0%) TW**

Dry cider with full, complex flavour from real cider apples

**Oakwood (E. Sussex), *English Organic Cider* (6.0%) TW**

**Oakwood, *English Organic Perry* (6.0%) TW**

Made with fruit grown on Oakwood Farm

**Pembury (Kent), *Medium Dry* (6.0%) TW**

Made by blending up to eight locally grown apple varieties

**Turners Cider (Kent), *Elderflower Cider* (6.0%) GR**

Medium cider made with Kentish apples plus elderflower syrup

**Turners Cider, *Perry* (6.5%) TW**

Dessert pears and some Bramley apple juice create a medium perry

**Turners Cider, *Russet* (8.5%) TW**

Medium dry cider made from Kentish Russets. Distinct nutty notes

**Wise Owl (Kent), *Dry Cider* (6.0%) TW**

Made of eight different apples milled & pressed on the premises

**Yellowcoate (E. Sussex), *Elderflower Cider* (6.0%) TW**

**Yellowcoate, *Medium Cider* (6.0%) TW**

Made with culinary apples, with or without elderflower syrup
